What stories do you think are to come? I personally invite you to come and be part of the Greensburg UMC church family – to come and worship each Sunday this month. Our youth will lead in worship July 14. We will celebrate Advent on July 21 – yes with music and everything. We will be gearing up for Vacation Bible School and hear the ROAR of our kids. Come and see what God is doing. You won't want to miss out.




