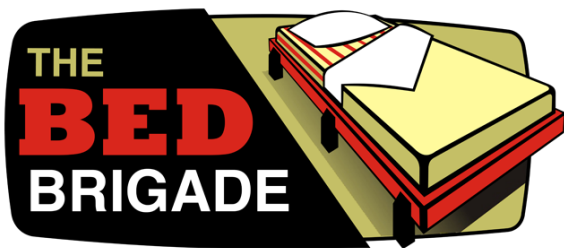
UMCOR CLEANING BUCKETS
